Re: Street Sign Repair/Replacement

Over the coming months, you may notice that some street name signs have been taken down temporarily. Several of our wooden street signs are rotted out and need to be replaced. Or the backer board may need replaced. Others may just need repainting. In the worst cases, the street sign post has rotted out and needs replaced as well.

We have found a local business who we believe can replicate our street signs so that the new ones look the same as existing. It will make the most sense for him to do approximately 10 at a time so you may see these temporary removals come in waves.

We expect this process to continue over several months. Please don't be concerned if your street name sign is taken down. It will be replaced with a new or refurbished one. If your sign post is taken down and it includes a stop sign, we will immediately put up a traditional stop sign in its place for safety.

We are also aware that many of the laminated wood backer boards on some of our stop signs are delaminating. These backer boards serve no function and will be removed over time beginning in the next few months.
